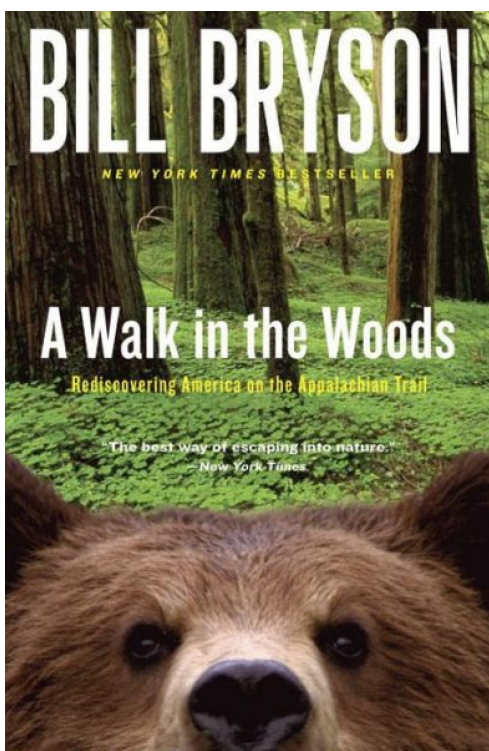


# July Book Club!

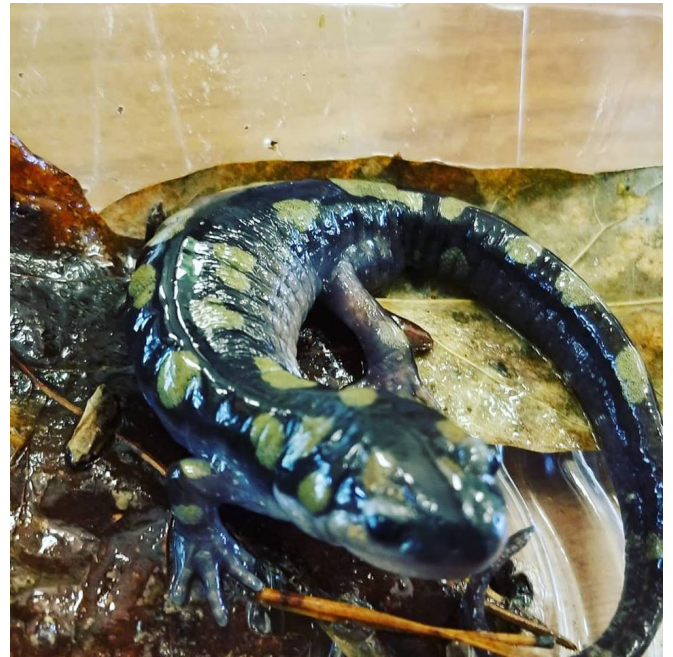
